#### 1.0 PURPOSE:

To approve the temporary closure of 57<sup>th</sup> Avenue as requested by the 4-H Alberta Northwest Region.

### 2.0 BACKGROUND AND DISCUSSION:

Back in the Fall of 2019 4-H Alberta chose the Barrhead community to host their 2020 and their 2021 Northwest Region event. Due to the pandemic, the 2021 event was unfortunately cancelled. On June 29, 2022 the Town was contacted by 4-H Alberta Northwest Region requesting to close  $57^{th}$  avenue for their event scheduled for July  $8^{th} - 10^{th}$ , 2022.

Focus on 4-H Alberta is a week-end event organized on behalf of the Northwest Region with the goal of showcasing their year's achievements and growth.

4-H Alberta will be utilizing the Barrhead & District Agricultural Society's facilities as well as the Town's Agrena. The noted road closure would allow their group to safety travel back and forth between the agrena and the Ag. Society's grounds.

We are still waiting confirmation from 4-H, but in 2020 the Town was anticipating to see approximately 250 registered youths along with an additional 150 parents/volunteers.

Administration has advised the local Chamber of Commerce and Barrhead County of this event.

4-H is also seeking a discount on the Town's swimming pass for their event. The current entrance fees are \$4.00 for children age 3-12 and \$5.50 from 13-17. During the November 26, 2019 Council meeting, Council authorizes "a Tonnie Swim" pass for each participant for the 2020 event.

#### 3.0 ALTERNATIVES:

- 3.1 Council approve the request by 4-H Alberta Northwest Region and temporary close a portion of 57 avenue for their event scheduled for July 8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- 3.2 Council deny the request by 4-H Alberta Northwest Region to temporary close a portion of 57 avenue for their event scheduled for July 8<sup>th</sup> 10<sup>th</sup>, 2022.

#### 4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

Limited to the expense of having the Town staff to erect and dismantle the required barricades.

## 5.0 INTERDEPARTMENTAL IMPLICATIONS:

This request will be coordinated by the Town's Public Works Department.



#### TOWN OF BARRHEAD

#### PROCEDURE STATEMENT

(Policy 32-010) Road Closures

Effective Date: 08/09/08

#### PROCEDURES:

The Municipal Manager will approve certain roads to be automatically closed for functions that occur on an annual basis in the Town of Barrhead.

- .1 The following roads will be closed to accommodate for the Town of Barrhead's annual functions:
  - a) Last Saturday in May of each year <u>Antique Car Rally</u> 57 Avenue, from the east corner of the museum to the lane, which runs north towards the seed cleaning plant, and the service road in front of the museum

Or

All or part of 50 Street (Main Street) from 50 Avenue to 49 Street and side street 51<sup>st</sup> Avenue to 51<sup>st</sup> Street West between the Scotiabank and Barrhead Bakery to Clarahan Accounting.

All or part of 50th Street (Main Street) from 49th Street to 50th Avenue

- b) 1st or 2nd Saturday in June <u>Blue Heron Street Festival</u> 50 Street from 49 Street to 50 Avenue
- c) 1st or 2nd Friday in June <u>Soap Box Derby</u> 47 Avenue, just south of the Co-op
- d) Last Friday or Saturday in June <u>Graduation</u> 57 Avenue from 48 Street to 46 Street
- e) July of each year <u>Santa's Toy Box Christmas in July</u> Service Road in front of Splash Park
- f) 2<sup>nd</sup> Weekend in August <u>Blue Heron Fair</u> 57 Avenue from 48 Street to 46 Street; 50 Street from 49 Street to 50 Avenue

g) 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday in November - <u>Christmas Light Up & Christmas</u> Parade - 50 Street from 50 Avenue to 52 Avenue

Emergency Services and the Public Services Department will be notified in advance of the above road closures. Barricades will be put up and taken down, upon request, by Town Public Services Staff.

Any new requests for road closures will be presented to Council for approval and if successful, will thereafter be added to the policy as an annual Town of Barrhead road closure item.
